Mission

Mission: To build wealth for low-to-moderate income entrepreneurs in North Minneapolis and surrounding communities.

Vision: To transform North Minneapolis and the surrounding area into a prosperous, visible, sustainable, and highly diverse multi-cultural community of entrepreneurs.

NEON

Northside Economic Opportunity Network (NEON) launched in 2006 to support North Minneapolis' underserved, ethnically diverse entrepreneurs, and has evolved to meet the dynamic needs of our community through individualized business development and assessment services, training programs and workshops. Each year, NEON provides nearly 1,000 aspiring entrepreneurs and small business owners—90% BIPOC (including 80% Black) and 100% low-to-moderate income—with the tools, resources, and access to capital and expertise needed to plan, launch, grow, and thrive in North Minneapolis. The community impact of NEON's services and investments is multi-generational.

Research completed by the Association for Enterprise Opportunity (AEO) documents that Black households in the United States possess on average about one-tenth the median net worth of White households. This wealth gap is perpetuated by a cycle of little to no intergenerational wealth transfer among Black Americans to their children, especially those born in the U.S. Consequently, home ownership and other asset-building activities are suppressed, the ability to locate into higher-quality school systems is thwarted, and fewer people receive postsecondary education.

To break the cycle, economic opportunity must be created and supported. A key pathway to generational wealth is through business ownership. AEO research has shown that the median net worth for Black business owners is 12 times higher than Black non-business owners.

NEON helps to build sustainable businesses with family-supporting jobs and wages. NEON plays a critical role ensuring development in North Minneapolis is driven by Northsiders, for Northsiders.



2026 7.0 Event Series

NEON's Community Conversation Series has become a cornerstone of our community engagement since its launch in 2020. Building on six successful years, the upcoming Community Conversation 7.0 Series continues this popular forum, which has engaged more than 1,500 community members through in-person events over the past five years. With this next series, we anticipate expanded visibility and an even greater platform for NEON's mission.

Designed to foster meaningful, strategic dialogue, the series features panel discussions that convene BIPOC-owned businesses and entrepreneurs, NEON leadership, and invited guest speakers. Together, they explore issues of social and racial equity, economic opportunity, and community-driven support for NEON initiatives.

The 7.0 Series will include three sessions with dynamic speakers, each followed by a networking reception to deepen connections and collaboration. These gatherings also provide a unique opportunity to bring together leading donors and community partners to learn more about and support NEON's 20th Anniversary Celebration.

NEON Collective Kitchen's Grand Opening

NEON Collective Kitchens is a major capital project created by NEON to support food-based entrepreneurs and revitalize the economic landscape of North Minneapolis.

Purpose & Goals

North Minneapolis has historically lacked accessible commercial kitchen space, which is a significant barrier for food entrepreneurs (like food truck, caterers, packaged goods, producers, and restaurants). Collective Kitchens aims to:

- Provide affordable, shared commercial kitchen space for food business creation and scaling
- Support entrepreneurs with equipment, classrooms, and collaboration spaces
- Foster community connection, business growth, and innovation

Facility Features

Collective Kitchens is a nearly 25,000 sqft facility which will include:

- Shared commercial kitchens and private/custom kitchen suites
- Food storage, packaging, and prep areas
- Retail kitchen spaces and food-hall-style customer areas
- Classrooms and training spaces for entrepreneurs and community members

NEON's Kitchen is located on West Broadway Ave near the Capri Theatre in North Minneapolis.
